## OFFICIALS CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

All Officials at all times shall conduct themselves in a fit and proper manner and refrain from engaging in any conduct or activity which will or is likely to bring the Darts Victoria or their Administrators or representatives into disrepute.

In particular the following expectations of behaviour are to be observed:

- Ensure that all competition conditions and rules are observed.
- If a dispute over a decision is to be questioned the game must be stopped and officials called.
- Control your temper no criticism by word or gesture and sledging of players, administrators or other officials.
- Cooperate with players, administrators and other officials.
- Show respect to all players.
- Be friendly to all.
- Be friendly to all participants, administrators and other officials.
- Officials are not permitted to consume alcoholic beverages whilst acting in their official capacity.
- The taking of non-prescribed drugs is forbidden.
- Complement and encourage all participants.
- Be consistent and courteous when making decisions as per the playing rules of the competition.
- Place the safety and welfare of the participants above all else.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, religion or disability.
- Officials must use appropriate language at all times when participating with all people at a tournament.
- Officials officiating at DV events must wear DV dress code attire.
