

DARTS VICTORIA PLAYERS PLAYING POLICY

All players at all times shall conduct themselves in accordance with the player code of conduct and refrain from engaging in any conduct or activity which will or is likely to bring the Darts Victoria or their officials or representatives into disrepute.

In particular the following expectations of behaviour are to be observed:

- Compete by the competition conditions and rules.
- If a dispute over a decision is to be questioned the game must be stopped and officials called
- Control your temper – no criticism by word or gesture of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- Be a good sport – encourage and support your own team members until completion of match, event or contest.
- Cooperate with your teammates.
- Show respect for your opponents.
- Be friendly to all participants.
- Do not drink alcoholic beverages in between the dartboard and the front of the team table.
- No alcohol beverages whilst playing on stage in finals.
- Drinking of alcoholic beverages only at the table except at designated tournament where the no drinking rule is enforced.
- Any player under the age of 18 entering a licensed premises must be accompanied by a parent or designated guardian (letter stating designated guardianship must be sighted by DV official).
- The taking of non-prescribed drugs is forbidden.
- If under the age of 18 years, entering licensed premises unless with or authorised by a Darts Victoria representative, team official or parents is forbidden.
- Observe common courtesies.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, religion or disabilities.

Note: it is the responsibility of the players, administrators, officials and coaches to obtain and keep a copy of the Darts Victoria Codes of Conduct.
